If you meet these guidelines, please attach the following information to your advising request:

- 1. A description of the thesis project you hope to pursue. Please describe, at a minimum, your proposed research topic, hypotheses and empirical approach (if applicable), and expected timeline for completion
- 2. An explanation of why you believe I would be an appropriate advisor for your project
